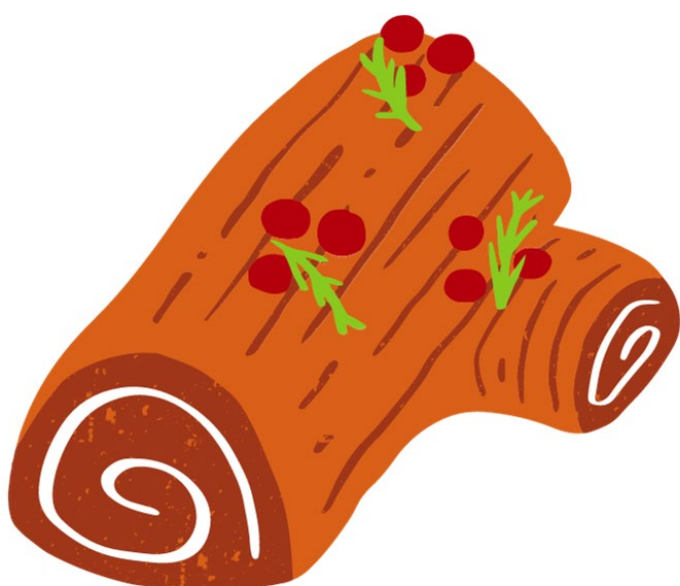


Mr Cook's Yule Log

Mr Cook likes to make a Yule Log for his grandkids. He looks for his cookbook from when he was a child. He has been making this Yule Log for decades! It's still as good as ever. A Yule Log is a cake in the shape of a log you might see in a woodland. Mr Cook must first put eggs, sugar and cocoa powder in a bowl and whisk them well. Then, he smooths the mix on a baking sheet. When it is cooked, he puts lots of whipped cream on it. Then, he must roll it

up. If he made the mix right, it should look just like a log.



Mr Cook gets his grandkids to help him finish it. They spoon chocolate mix on top and add a sprig of holly. The best bit is eating the Yule Log. His grandkids say it tastes very good.
