

## *MFL (French) Curriculum Statement*

### *Intent*

The core language taught at Chadsmoor Junior School is French. Our planning is based on the Twinkl 'Plan it' scheme of work which covers all the components of the Programme of Study. It is the intention that all children in KS2 will access first quality teaching of French in order to adequately prepare them for High School.

### *Implementation*

Our curriculum has developed and continues to develop over time. We currently use the Twinkl 'Plan it' units throughout the school as they provide opportunities for quality listening (including the correct pronunciation of vocabulary) and units progress across each year group with links to prior learning and reference to the National Curriculum. Children have weekly lessons in French throughout Key Stage 2, using the Twinkl programme of study in addition to other resources. Areas covered include: numbers, colours, house and home, in town, food and drink, the classroom, clothes and hobbies

### *Impact*

We evaluate the knowledge, skills and understanding that the pupils have gained against the assessment criteria at the end of each unit ensuring that children are supported and challenged as appropriate. By giving the children a good start in their language learning we hope to engage them in the subject as well as provide them with the knowledge and skills necessary to continue their studies successfully at High School.
