

EYFS Long Term Curriculum

Topic Plan

In Foundation Stage, we follow a two-year cycle of topics. Both Nursery and Reception follow the same topic to ensure we share experiences and work together as a team. The two year cycle also guarantees that learners who spend more than one year in Foundation Stage receive a broader Curriculum. Activities are differentiated for Nursery or Reception within each topic and are age and stage appropriate. We use Cornerstones as a basis for all of our topics, except Autumn 1 where Nursery pupils follow a Transition Topic: 'All About Me'. There is a **Main Topic** for each half term, and in Reception, we have a **Companion Project** that relates to the season or supports the main topic







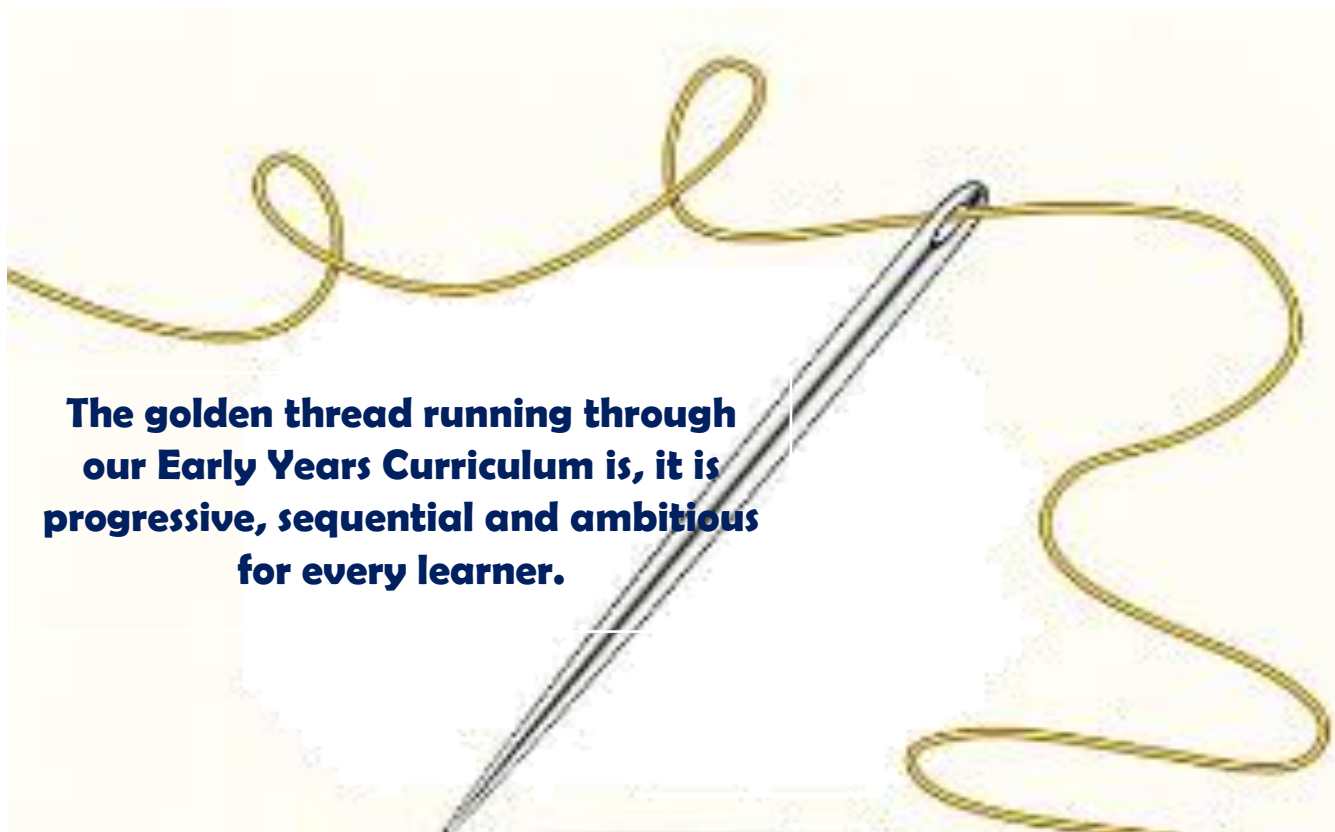
